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ABSTRACT

An abstract is a single paragraph, without indentation, compendious summary of a paper's substance including research question, background, purpose, methodology, results, and conclusion in 300 to 500 words. This one-page abstract should be prepared in the following format: (1) Use a sheet of A4 size paper. (2) Use 12 points Times New Roman for the main text and smaller fonts may be used for figure captions. (3) The width of each line should not exceed 17.5 cm or 7.0 inch. (4) Insert two blank lines between the email addresses and the main text. (5) Start the first line of the main text by leaving no space. (6) Main text should be fully justified with a single spacing. (7) Use bold face with bigger fonts for title but not for authors, affiliations, and the main text. (8) Please underline the presenting author if possible. (9) Leave the space of 2.5 cm or 1.0 inch at least on the bottom of the text. Page number will be printed there. (9) Up to 6 keywords are mandatory. (10) Figures and References are optional.
